<u>Resolution No. 114/2009</u> <u>Amending Some Provisions of Resolution NO 8/2008 on Dealing with</u> <u>Telecommunications Activities</u>

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Regulatory Act issued by the Royal Decree No. 30/2002 and;

The Executive Regulations issued by Resolution No. 144/2008; and

The approval of the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority in its meeting obtained on 3rd November 2009 and;

Based on the exigencies of the public interest;

It is decided:

- Article 1 The Serial No (11) of Table (E) attached with Resolution No 8/2008 shall be deleted.
- Article 2 A new Article shall be added to the Resolution No (8/2008) as (No1) Repeated to read as follows:

"GPS Receiver Equipment and Echo Sounder equipment shall be exempted from type approval regulations on the basis of this Resolution, where this equipment shall be exempted on the following basis:

- a. The equipment shall be a GPS satellite receiver.
- b. The equipment shall not have the ability to send radio frequencies.
- **Article 3** This Resolution shall be published in the Gazette and shall become into force from the date following its publication.
