## **Decision No. 124/2010**

On the conditions to exempt all who establish, operate, or Provide Mobile Telecommunications Services on board of Aircrafts from the obligation to obtain Telecommunications Licenses

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Regulatory Act issued by the Royal Decree No. 30/2002 and;

The Executive Regulation issued by the Ministerial Decision No. 144/2008 and;

The decision No. 133/2008 issuing the regulation organizing the registration and the utilization of frequencies and radio equipment and their pricing and;

The approval of the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority in its meeting No. 6/2010 dated 12<sup>th</sup> October 2010 and;

Based on the exigencies of the public interest;

## It is decided:
